

Personal Visitation Rules

- **Personal Visitation:** Each inmate is allowed 1 hour of personal visitation per weekend (Friday through Monday). This may be taken as one 1 hour visit or as two ½ hour visits. Inmates who receive no visits on one weekend may receive an additional hour visiting the following weekend. Visitation may be stored up to a maximum of 4 hours in this manner
- **Scheduling a Visit:** Public visiting is from 8:00AM-8:00PM Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday, excluding meal times. If you wish to visit an inmate you must schedule your visit at least 1 hour in advance and you must bring photo identification (phone 541-575-1134). Scheduling your visit up to seven days in advance is allowed, and scheduling more than an hour in advance is recommended as visiting times are scheduled on a first come first serve basis.
- **First time visiting:** Arrive about ten minutes early the first time you visit as you will need to fill out a visitation form. If you wish to fill it out in advance and bring it with you click here (print the form and hand write your information): <G:\website\Personal Visiting Form.pdf>
- **Denial of Visiting:** Certain persons may not be allowed to visit including:
 - You have been incarcerated in this facility in the last 30 days;
 - You are a victim or witness in the inmate's case;
 - You are under 18 years of age, and not accompanied by a parent or guardian;
 - The inmate chooses not to see you or has used all of their visitation time for the week
 - Your clothing does not meet the minimum requirements;
Shorts, skirts, and dresses shall extend to mid-thigh, seated and slits in skirts and dresses shall rise no higher than mid-thigh, seated.
The top of clothing shall be no lower than the underarm in the front and back.
Bare midriffs and strapless tops, tube tops, and swimsuits are prohibited.
Shoes shall be worn at all times.
Gang "colors" and other gang displays are prohibited.
- All persons and property are subject to search before visiting, or entering the facility.
- Handbags, purses or carry items are not permitted and must be locked in your vehicle or left at home.

Visiting Do's and Don'ts

Visiting Do's:

- **Schedule at least 1 hour in advance (further ahead if possible)**
- **Wear appropriate clothing**
- **Bring photo ID**
- **If under 18 bring a parent or legal guardian**
- **Leave handbags, purses, cell phones, or carry items behind**

Visiting Don'ts:

- **Don't let the visit get loud, emotional, or confrontational (your visit will be ended if this happens)**
- **No flashing or inappropriate gestures (your visit will be ended, and you may not be allowed to return)**
- **Don't bring the inmate anything, it will not be accepted**
- **Don't carry messages for the inmate, especially to victims or witnesses**
